

# 2007-2009

## Proposal about Barbara Petchenik Map Competition

Possible method to evaluate by points the submitted maps:

- Jury is conformed by 9 members (CCC, national organizers, invited specialists) and 1 Chairman (proposed by CCC Chairman and approved by ICA EC)
- Jury members can not vote for their own country entries.
- Each member proposes a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each age group (under 9, 9-12 and 13-15)
- Proposed : 5 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place, 3 points for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 2 points for 3<sup>rd</sup> place.
- Jury Chairman is responsible for summing the votes and announcing the results
- Total sum of points determines the final place of entry: first three maps in each age group are prized + a public prize by each age group (12 winners?)

## Proposal about Barbara Petchenik Map Competition

- Process of judgment: Before or during ICC?

Before ICC	During ICC
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Members do not need to have „personal” contact, because all the process is finished by email.</li><li>- Members should decide without appreciating the original maps, only their scanned version</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Members should participate in ICC conference (it can be difficult to group 10 members...)</li><li>- Members can evaluate the original works, changing their opinions if they consider it necessary...</li></ul>

*„Email” Jury composed by 10 members + „Smaller” BPC panel to take final decisions during ICC? (eg. if the number of votes is the same for two maps...)*

*This panel can be composed by three members proposed by Jury Chairman...*

# 2007-2009

## Proposal about Barbara Petchenik Map Competition

- Announcement of results: before ICC or in Closing Ceremony?

<b>Before ICC</b>	<b>Actual format</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Entries are exhibited by countries, but indicating the winners selected previously by Jury...</li><li>- Can this solution influence the public vote?</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Entries exhibited only by countries</li><li>- Public vote has no any kind of „extern” influence</li></ul>

*This question is independent from the previous one: Jury can decide before ICC, but the result is kept secret during the conference and announced only in the Closing Ceremony.*

# 2007-2009

## Proposal about Barbara Petchenik Map Competition

- Actual format: a total of 10 winners
  - 7 prizes selected by the Jury, to be distributed between the three age groups and
  - 3 prizes given by public vote, one prize/age group
- This new proposal includes a total of 12 winners
  - 3 prizes/age group (Jury) 9 prizes
  - 1 prize/age group (public vote) + 3 prizes
- *Authors of the three best maps could be invited to next ICC conference. They could draw together a wallmap during the event...*

### **FINANCIAL DECISION TO BE TAKEN BY ICA EC!!!**

- Jury can give special mentions without any financial remuneration, but they can receive diploma. *E.g. If in a specific competition are received works from Special Schools...*

This is an initial proposal based on Bulgarian experiences during the judging of maps sent to the national competition. We would like to ask all the interested colleagues to send their opinions, remarks, etc before January 10, 2008. We are sure that your participation is going to be very useful to take our final decision during our next meeting in the conference in *Borovets, Bulgaria (January 21-24, 2008).*
